## MISSION

To function as a community oriented fine arts organization dedicated to making the arts accessible to the people of Suffolk and the surrounding communities.

## MEMBERSHIP

Membership is open to all without regard to race, religion, national origin, sex or special needs. Members receive Suffolk Art League newsletters, invitations and announcements for events and exhibits and reduced fees for classes and workshops.

Suffolk Art League is supported by memberships, donations, fundraising, and Suffolk Fine Arts Commission, state, local and corporate grants.

## PROGRAMS

**CLASSES** are conducted by local and regional artists and artists from the Virginia Museum of Fine Arts. In-school, gallery, community and VMFA programs are offered for the public, school systems, day care centers, and home schools.

**WORKSHOPS** are held at Western Tidewater Community Services Board's Tidewater House and other community programs. **EXHIBITS** programming gives artists exhibition opportunities with receptions featuring live music. **SCHOLARSHIPS** for students in grades six through twelve who are interested in exploring and pursuing the arts are offered annually.

## EVENTS & EXHIBITIONS

Through a strong partnership with the City of Suffolk Department of Parks and Recreation, SAL offers a rich variety of quality events and exhibits. Annual Events are the Antiques Show and Sale, the Annual Juried Exhibition, a Solo Exhibit of the winner of the Juried Exhibition, The Exhibit of Excellence Student Art Exhibit and the Open Members Show.

The Suffolk Art Gallery, located in historic Lakeside, serves as headquarters of the Suffolk Art League.
